

Addressing some 75 young leaders of the various Syro-Malabar Eparchies of the diaspora and the Apostolic Visitation in Europe, Pope Francis noted that as Christians our wish is to follow Jesus and "walk along his path of love, the sole path that leads to eternal life."

Though not easy, he said, this path "is exciting" and "gives meaning to our lives. It gives us the strength to say 'yes' to a life of service and responsibility, and 'no' to one of superficiality and dissipation."



ക്രിസ്തുവിലുള്ള വിശ്വാസത്തിന്റെ പേരിൽ ക്രൈസ്തവർ പീഠിപ്പിക്കപ്പെടുന്ന രാജ്യങ്ങൾ ഇന്നു ലോകത്തിലുണ്ട്. ഭാരതത്തി ലാകട്ടെ മതത്തിന്റെ പേരിലുള്ള പീഠനങ്ങൾ ആവർത്തിക്കാതിരിക്കാൻ ശക്തമായ കരുതലുകൾ ഭരണകർത്താക്കൾ എടുത്തു വരുന്നു. അത് എക്കാലവും തുടരുന്നതിനു വേണ്ടി നമുക്ക് പ്രാർത്ഥിക്കാം സങ്കു ചിതമായ വിക്ഷണങ്ങളോടെ പ്രവർത്തിക്കുന്ന വ്യക്തികളെയും

സീറോ – മലബാർസഭയെ സംബന്ധിച്ചിടത്തോളം ഈ സഭ യുടെ കേരളത്തിലുള്ള രൂപതകളെ മാതൃസഭയായിട്ടാണ് പരിഗണി കുന്നത്. ഈ മാതൃസഭ കേരളത്തിന് പുറത്ത് ഇന്ത്യയിലും ഇന്ത്യകു പുറത്ത് മറ്റു രാജ്യങ്ങളിലുമുള്ള സഭാസമുഹങ്ങളുടെ പ്രേക്ഷിത പ്രവൃത്തനങ്ങൾക്ക് സഹകരണം നൽകുവാൻ സർവ്വാത്മനാ പരിശ്ര മിക്കേണ്ടതാണ്. ക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ സനേഹവും കാരുണ്വവും അറിയി കുകയും അതിനു സാക്ഷ്വം വഹിക്കുകയുമാണ് യഥാർത്ഥമായ പ്രേഷിതത്വം. അതിനുപകരിക്കുന്ന എല്ലാ നല്ല പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളിലും ഏർപ്പെടാൻ നാം പരിശ്രമിക്കണം. സുവിശേഷപ്രവർത്തനങ്ങൾക്ക് ആളും അർത്ഥവും നൽകി പരസ്പരം സഹായിക്കാൻ നാം ഏവരും തയ്യറാകണം. ഇപ്രകാരം പ്രവർത്തിക്കുമ്പോൾ എല്ലാ മനുഷ്വ രോടും ക്രസ്തുവിന്റെ സാർവത്രികസ്നേഹം പങ്കുവയ്ക്കാൻ നമുക്ങ് സാധിക്കേണ്ടതാണ്.

കാർഷികമേഖലയിലുള്ള നമ്മുടെ ജനങ്ങൾ കടന്നുപോകുന്ന കഷ്ടതകൾക്കു പരിഹാരം കാണേണ്ടതുണ്ട്. കർഷകരും അസംഘ ടിത തൊഴിൽ വിഭാഗങ്ങളും ഉപജീവനത്തിനുവേണ്ടി കഷ്പപ്പെടുക യാണ് എന്നതു യാഥാർത്ഥ്യമാണ്. സംഘടിത വിഭാഗങ്ങൾ തങ്ങളുടെ സുരക്ഷിതത്വം വർദ്ധിഷിക്കുന്നതിനുവേണ്ടി സമ്മർദം ചെലുത്തുമ്പോൾ സർക്കാരും ഉദ്യോഗസ്ഥരും അവഗണിക്കുന്നതു കർഷകരെയും അസംഘിടിത വിഭാഗങ്ങളെയുമാണ്. പ്രകൃതിക്ഷോഭം, വന്വമൃഗശല്വം എന്നിവയാൽ കർഷകരുടെ ജീവിതം ദുരിതപൂർണ്ണമായിരിക്കുന്നു. കർഷകരുടെ ഉൽഷന്നങ്ങൾക്കു ന്യായവില ഉറഷാക്കാനും അതു വഴി ഒരു നിശ്ചിതവരുമാനം കർഷക കുടുംബങ്ങൾക്ക് ഉറഷാ ക്കാനും ഇതുവരെ ഫലപ്രദമായ ഒരു നടപടിയും മാറിവരുന്ന സർ ക്കാരുകൾ സ്വീകരിച്ചിട്ടില്ല എന്നത് വസ്തുതയാണ്. ഭാരതത്തിന്റെ പരമോന്നത നീതിപീഠം ബഫർസോൺ സംബന്ധിച്ചു നൽകിയിരി കുന്ന പുതിയ ഉത്തരവ് ആയിരക്കണക്കിനു കർഷകകുടുംബ ങ്ങളെ വഴിയാധാരമാക്കാൻ ഇടയാക്കുമെന്ന ആശങ്ക നിലനിൽ കുന്നു. ഈ വിഷയത്തിൽ സർക്കാർ ജാഗ്രതയോടെ സത്വരമായി ഇടപ്പെടുകയും കർഷകരുടെ പ്രത്യേക സാഹചര്വം ബഹു. കോട തിയെ അറിയിക്കാൻ ആവശ്യമായ നടപടികൾ സ്വീകരിക്കുകയും ചെയ്യണം. കർഷകരെപോലെ മറ്റു അസംഘിടിതവിഭാഗങ്ങളിലെ മനുഷ്യർക്കും നീതിയും തുല്യതയും ഉറഷാക്കാനും മാന്വമായ രീതിയിൽ അധ്വാനിച്ചു ജീവിക്കാൻ സാഹചര്യങ്ങൾ ജനാധിപത്യ സംവിധാനത്തിൽ ഒരുക്കുകയും ചെയ്യേണ്ടത് സർക്കാരിന്റെ കടമ യാണ്.



A Spiritual Oasis in a dusty, arid land - a fascinating travel experience

The Quirky Jewel of The Outback: Coober Pedy, South Australia

t's one of the unique places I visited in Australia. Coober Pedy (meaning white man Doug out) is located roughly halfway between Adelaide and Darwin in South Australia (with little life in between!) It's 846 kilometres north of Adelaide on the Stuart Highway.

On the drive up from Streaky Bay, we drove past a gorgeous landscape of salt lakes and vibrant desert colours. You may recognise the mysterious lunar landscape surrounding this town that rises from the desert floor.

You're almost at Coober Pedy

when you start seeing mounds of dirt piled up as far as the eye can see – it's the waste excavated by the opal mines. Hot, dry, desolate, quiet, dusty and burnt orange colour landscape all around. Coober Pedy is the biggest supplier of Opals in the world. Opal was first found in Coober Pedy on 1 February 1915 when a teenager, William Hutchison, stumbled on the "Surface Opal Nobbies" while gold prospecting with his father.


Cober Pedi has spectacular-coloured hills, flat-topped mesas and gibber-covered plains (locally referred to as "moon plain"). This region is a breathtaking landscape. From a distance, the low hills scattered across the horizon appear to have 'broken away' from the higher escarpment of the nearby Stuart Range, giving rise to the name 'The Breakaways'.

The air is not cool. It is really hot. So hot that people are forced to live underground! That is what makes it intriguing. It's not just the homes that are underground; the shops, hotels, swimming pools, churches and even a campground are all under the earth.

Visiting some of the local underground churches was a once-

in-a-lifetime experience, St Peter and Paul Catholic Church, a Serbian orthodox church and an Anglican church named after the Catacombs in Rome.

The time we spent inside St Peter and Paul Catholic Church was incredibly ascetic. Australia's first underground church was dug out of sandstone in the shape of a cross. Once inside, St Paul and St Peter's Catholic church has a comforting appeal, with its statue-filled nooks and soothing classical music. A quiet place of meditation and prayer, the church provides a regular Sunday service for about 40 worshippers. The church's interior is chiselled from natural rock and coated with a special sealant to prevent dust from settling. The temperature inside the underground church is a pleasant 25C all year long. The church is open 24 hours a day. The ambience inside the church will move you and leave you feeling humbled and connected with your inner self. It will take you inside its pleasant, peaceful womb as if to shelter you from the harsh world outside. What an ascetic feeling! A real spiritual oasis.



Impact of Syro-Malabar's support for the people of Ukraine



As the war in Ukraine continues relentlessly, we are proud to partner with Fr Eugen Blaj, the National Director of the PMS in Romania, to provide emergency relief to fleeing refugees.

This project is providing immediate and vital relief to those in need who make the 13+ hour drive (longer for those who cannot access a vehicle) to safety in Romania. The generosity of the Syro-Malabar community in Australia has helped Fr Eugen respond to the needs of a growing number of refugees entering Romania. They come traumatised and are so grateful for this support which includes providing full board, medicine, food and water, money and transport costs. Above all, they are provided with a safe place to begin the recovery process as they rebuild their lives. The continuing conflict in Ukraine impacts on the cost of living in Romania, which continues to rise, making this project vital to the needs of the refugees there.

"The refugees are extraordinary people, accepting their situation and being ready to start a new life from zero. Strong people, trying to discern what to do every day, in a context in which you may not know when the war finishes."





STANDARD 5



Robust Human Resource Management

People working with children are suitable and supported to reflect child safeguarding values in practice

CRITERION 5.1

Recruitment, including advertising, interview questions. Referee checks and pre- employment sceening, emphasises child safeguarding

Indicators

- 5.1.1 The entity emphasizes its commitment to child safeguarding and zero- tolerance approach to child abuse in all aspects of its advertising, screening and recruitment for personnel.
- 5.1.2 The entity documents its child safeguarding approach in recruitment and screening procedures and processes.

- 5.1.3 Positions are assessed for the expected level of contact with children and appropriate child safeguarding recruitment procedures are implemented.
- 5.1.4 Position descriptions, selection criteria, reference check and interview questions articulate:
 - That children are valued and respected;
 - The commitment of the entity to child safeguarding; and
 - Where appropriate to the role [refer indicator 5.1.3], an understanding of children's developmental needs culturally safe practices.

CHILD SAFEGUARDING





CRITERION 5.2

Relevant personnel (including all seminarians, clergy and religious) have current working with children checks or equivalent background checks

Indicators

- 5.2.1 The entity has a policy which is implemented that ensures :
 - Personnel have a current working with children check as required by legislation prior to working with children; and
 - Where a working with children check is not required by legislation, other back ground Checks for personnel are conducted prior to working with children.
- 5.2.2 The entity keeps records and monitors the status of working with children Checks and/ or background checks for all personnel.

"Criminal background checks are of limited effectiveness unless accompanied by other child safe recruitment practices."

Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexaual Abuse.

CRITERION 5.3

Personnel receive an appropriate induction and are aware of their child safeguarding responsibilities, including reporting obligations.

Indicators

- 5.3.1 All personnel participate in a safeguarding induction program, which occurs as soon as possible after commencement
- 5.3.2 All Church Authorities (along with members of their leadership team) who are signatories to the Catholic Professional Standards Ltd Service Agreement participate in the National Catholic Safeguarding Standards Introductory Session for Leaders within four months of commencement.

CRITERION 5.4

Ongoing supervision and people management is focused on child safeguarding.

Indicators

- 5.4.1 Support, mentoring, oversight and professional supervision processes for personnel include child safeguarding [refer to indicator 5.5.3]
- 5.4.2 Annual performance reviews for personnel include child safeguarding responsibilities relevant to their role [refer to indicator 5.5.4]

UPDATES FROM THE YOUTH APOSTOLATE APRIL 2022 - JUNE 2022

ARISE 2022

The First Ever Leaders Meet of The Syro-Malabar Youth Living Outside India

The historic gathering of Syro-Malabar youth leaders outside of the India (combined mission)was held in Rome in the month of June 2022. 70 elected Youth from the four Eparchies (Chicago, Melbourne,

Mississauga and Great Britain) and the Apostolic Visitation to Europe is here with their own bishops and with His Beatitude Maran Mar George Alencherry, the Father and Head of the Syro-Malabar Church. His Eminence, Leonardo Cardinal Sandri, Prefect for the Dicastery for the Eastern Churches will give his Inaugural address this morning.

The event consists of talks, discussions, fellowship and a pilgrimage to the important sites in Rome too. The meeting will also feature a special audience with His Holiness Pope Francis. The gathering aims to enable Syro-Malabar youth who are building their lives in the western countries to move forward with missionary zeal and vigor for evangelisation.





Movement living in 12 countries from the Eparchies of USA, Canada, Great Britain, Oceania and the Apostolic Visitation of Europe come together with the Major Archbishop, Bishops and Youth Directors.

As a migrant community living in the western hemisphere, the pastoral concerns and challenges faced particularly by our families and youth are often discussed. We identified four areas where we need to concentrate more, Youth, Family, Catechesis and Liturgy. Most of the Syro-Malabar population in these ecclesiastical circumscriptions are below 40 years of age. Those youth and children born and brought up in western culture, face tremendous challenges to maintain their Syro-Malabar identity in the universal Church and, at the same time, struggle to maintain their relevance where they live. Hence, with the consent of the Syro-Malabar synod, we decided to organise a meeting of the youth leaders from the above places in 2020. Unfortunately, due to COVID, it was postponed.

Now we thought that it is the opportune time to hold such a meeting here in Rome, which is the centre of Catholicism. So we have come together for ARISE 2022 from 17 to 22 June. The purpose of this International Youth Leader's Summit is 1. Encounter Jesus Christ and deepen the personal relationship with Him 2. Experience the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church and its Apostolic and oriental tradition 3. Celebrate the universality of the Church 4. Engage the youth in the life and mission of the Church and, 5. Pilgrimage to the tomb of the Apostles to regain missionary vigour.

During this summit, we want to prayerfully reflect on our way forward and discern the pastoral and missionary call with renewed vigour and commitment. This summit helps also us to plan and prepare ourselves for the upcoming World Youth Day 2023.

Holy Father, here we are to seek your Apostolic Benediction and paternal Petrine pastoral guidance, especially to the migrant youth of the Syro-Malabar Church living in the western hemisphere.

Once again we assure your Holiness of our prayers, please remember us in your prayers.

Holy Father,

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First of all, we thank Your Holiness for your courageous Petrine ministry to the universal Church in these difficult times. We, sons and daughters of St. Thomas the Apostle, consider it a great privilege by the grace of God today to be with the successor of Peter, the head of the college of the Apostles. We assure you that, every day, we pray for Your Holiness so that you can lead the Church in her pilgrimage with the Lord and unto the Lord. We take this opportunity to thank Your Holiness, the Apostolic See, especially the Congregation for the Oriental Churches and its Prefect Leonardo Cardinal Sandri, for the care and concern shown towards the Syro-Malabar Church, especially outside India.

Thanks to the generous welcome and pastoral assistance from the part of the Latin hierarchy and the strenuous efforts of our Synod under the leadership of the Major Archbishop, the Apostolic See has graciously constituted four eparchies outside India for the Syro-Malabar migrants and an Apostolic Visitation in Europe. We take this opportunity to express our gratitude to our Major Archbishop for his paternal leadership.

SAY 'YES' TO A LIFE OF SERVICE AND RESPONSIBILITY

"In today's 'fluid', even 'frothy' culture, our lives find substance and meaning whenever we say 'yes' to Jesus."

BEAR WITNESS TO THE LOVE GIVEN BY THE SAINTS

Referring to the 1,950th anniversary of St. Thomas's martyrdom, Pope Francis reminded the Syro-Malabar young leaders that the Church is apostolic "because she is founded on the testimony of the Apostles, and continues to grow not by proselytism, but by witness."

He therefore called on them to bear witness to the love given by the saints in every age, primarily among their peers in the Syro-Malabar diaspora, but also among those who do not belong to their communities, and even those "who do not know the Lord Jesus".

CHRISTIANITY IS NOT A SERIES OF PROHIBITIONS

That love, Pope Francis noted, "shows – more than any words – that Christianity consists not in a series of prohibitions that stifle the desire for happiness, but in a life project capable of bringing fulfilment to every human heart."

"Don't be afraid to rebel against the growing tendency to reduce love to something banal, without beauty or genuine sharing and lacking in fidelity and responsibility."

STEP AWAY FROM THE "SOFA" OF COMFORT

Pope Francis further encouraged the young Indian pilgrims to follow Mary's example, referring to the theme of next World Youth Day in Lisbon: 'Mary arose and went with haste', drawn from the Gospel of Luke in which the Mother of God rushes to announce the Good News to Elizabeth.

He noted that "Mary did not allow herself to be paralyzed by pride or fear, after receiving the message of the angel."

"Mary was not one of those people for whom all it takes to be comfortable and secure is a good sofa: 'couch potatoes."

CULTIVATE RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE OLDER GENERATIONS

Pope Francis also remarked that the encounter between Mary and Elizabeth is an inspiring example of the "importance and fruitfulness of the encounter between young and old."

He encouraged the young leaders to cultivate their relationships with their elderly relatives and make good use of their wisdom, emphasizing that the older generations play a crucial role in transmitting the faith.

"If you, young people, want to make your own lives a canticle of praise, a gift for all humanity, you must be grounded in the tradition and prayer of past generations."

LIVE EUCHARISTICALLY

In conclusion, Pope Francis pointed out that Mary "teaches us also to live Eucharistically," in other words to give thanks, to cultivate praise, and not to be fixated only on problems and difficulties.

"In the course of life, today's fervent petitions become tomorrow's prayers of thanks giving," he said.





